On March 1, 2014 a *Legacy Offshore International* Saturation Diving Team successfully completed Bell Run #400 as part of a long term hurricane remediation project. This milestone was completed without a single lost time accident or injury. This accomplishment is noteworthy due to the major challenges this project presented, especially the fact that it was performed in 215 foot of sea water (fsw) in the Gulf of Mexico, with the last 45 foot below natural bottom.

When asked to comment on how the Legacy Team was able to operate in this extremely hazardous environment and still maintain a perfect safety record, Legacy Senior Project Manager, Gary Young said:

“This is a very challenging work site with a number of unique hazards. The difference with this team is that every member is focused on safety. These guys work together like a finely tuned engine, every member performing his job flawlessly while watching out for the other guys around him. If something doesn’t feel right, we stop and discuss what is going on and what needs to be changed. It doesn’t matter who spots the problem or the perceived problem. When it comes to Safety, everybody is the boss.”
